At the 2011 EAST Conference in Hot Springs, Arkansas, CEC's EAST team was honored as ranking among the top in the nation.

CEC is one of two schools east of the Mississippi River to offer this program and the only Catholic school to do so. Our program is the only one outside of Ar-

kansas to be recognized as one of the ten Founder's Award Finalists, out of more than 250 EAST schools across the country.

CEC was named Superior School, the highest confer-

ence rating, and our program won the Award of Excellence as one of the top three schools for the entire conference.
